 - Donated specialty care by Wake County physicians
 - Specialty slots are limited
 - Diagnostic tests through WakeMed, Rex and Duke Raleigh are donated
 - In-patient hospital care is donated; patient may be required to apply for Medicaid.
 - Project Access is the program of last resort, patients must apply for disability, Medicaid or Medicare based on those guidelines.
